FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 12

Please attend the All-State Jazz Band Concert at 10:30 am in the Ballroom, Convention Center. Come support other All-Staters!

- 10:30AM All-State Jazz Ensemble Concert (optional). Ballroom, Convention Center.
11:30-12:15PM Break and lunch. You may wish to bring your lunch with you.
12:15-12:45PM Register at Convention Center Room 200A. Eat lunch on your own before this registration period.
12:45–5:15PM All State Orchestra rehearses in Convention Center, Room 200A.
5:15–5:30PM Walk to Central Lutheran Church.
5:30-6:00PM Box lunch at Central Lutheran Church, Fellowship Hall.
6:00-6:15PM Walk to Convention Center.
6:15-7:15PM Rehearsal continues at Convention Center, Room 200A.
Parents can pick you up at this time or you may attend the **optional** concert at the Convention Center.
7:30-9:15PM **Optional** concert, Ballroom, Convention Center:
This is a joint concert with Legacy Chorale of Greater Minnesota and Medalist Concert Band. Parents can pick you up at the 2nd Avenue entrance to the Convention Center.

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 13

- 8:30-11:30AM Rehearsal at Convention Center, Room 200A. (Breakfast on your own prior to rehearsal.)
11:30AM Check out of hotel by 12:00 noon.
Lunch with your parents or dine on your own. Make sure you allow enough time to dress for the concert.
2:00PM Meet back stage at Orchestra Hall (1111 Nicollet Mall).
Enter Orchestra Hall through the performers entrance located on Marquette Ave (across from Symphony Place Apartments) between 11th and 12th Streets. Family members, friends, or other audience members must enter Orchestra Hall through the lobby.
2:00-4:30PM MMEA All-State Concert
The Concert Band performs first, the Orchestra is second and the Symphonic Band is third.

CONCERT DRESS

Concert attire will be black and white. Men should wear black or dark dress slacks and a white button-down shirt with a long dark tie. Women should wear a black or dark over-the-knee skirt or dark, loose-fitting dress slacks and a white blouse (no spaghetti straps or sleeveless blouses). Both men and women should wear black or dark shoes and socks.

ORCHESTRA HALL – THE INS AND OUTS

- Performers must enter and exit through the Stage Door, located on the Marquette Avenue side of the building (across from Symphony Place Apartments) between 11th and 12th Streets.
- Only performers and crew with backstage passes are allowed in the downstairs backstage area. Performers are not allowed to pass back and forth between backstage and the lobby.
- No food or beverage is allowed on stage or in the auditorium.

LUGGAGE

On Saturday, DO NOT bring your luggage to Orchestra Hall unless your parents can meet you there BEFORE the concert.
