**FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 12**

Please attend the All-State Jazz Band concert at 10:30 am in the Ballroom, Convention Center. Come support other All-Staters!

- 10:30AM All-State Jazz Ensemble Concert (optional). Ballroom, Convention Center  
11:30-12:00PM Break and lunch. You may wish to bring your lunch with you.  
12:00-12:15PM All-State Mixed Choir students meet in the hallway outside of the Ballroom and walk to Westminster Presbyterian Church (Nicollet @ 12<sup>th</sup> St.).  
12:15-12:30PM Register at Westminster Presbyterian Church. Eat lunch on your own before this registration period.  
12:30-4:45PM All-State Mixed Choir rehearses at Westminster Presbyterian Church. Please bring your music, a black folder, and a pencil.  
4:45-5:15PM Supper at Westminster, Great Room.  
5:15-6:40PM Rehearsal continues at Westminster Presbyterian Church.  
6:45-7:15PM Performance by CANTUS, Great Hall Westminster Presbyterian  
7:30-9:15PM **Optional** concert, Ballroom, Convention Center: Parents can pick you up at this time or you may attend the **optional** concert at the Convention Center.  
This is a joint concert with Legacy Chorale of Greater Minnesota and Medalist Concert Band. Parents can pick you up at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue entrance to the Convention Center.

**SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 13**

- 9:00AM Meet at Orchestra Hall. Breakfast on your own before coming to Orchestra Hall.  
9:30-10:00AM Rehearsal at Orchestra Hall.  
10:00-10:45AM Change into concert dress and check out of your rooms.  
10:45AM Meet back stage at Orchestra Hall in concert dress (1111 Nicollet Mall).  
Enter Orchestra Hall through the performers entrance located on Marquette Ave (across from Symphony Place Apartments) between 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Streets. Family members, friends, or other audience members must enter Orchestra Hall through the lobby.  
10:30-12:30PM MMEA All-State Concert.  
The Women's Choir performs first, the Men's Choir is second and the Mixed Choir is third.  
12:30PM Have lunch and head home.

**CONCERT DRESS**

Concert attire is your high school robe, tuxedo, dress or whatever you wear for your school concerts.

**ORCHESTRA HALL – THE INS AND OUTS**

- Performers must enter and exit through the Stage Door, located on the Marquette Avenue side of the building (across from Symphony Place Apartments) between 11th and 12th Streets.
- Only performers and crew with backstage passes are allowed in the downstairs backstage area. Performers are not allowed to pass back and forth between backstage and the lobby.
- No food or beverage is allowed on stage or in the auditorium.

**LUGGAGE**

Check into your hotel and drop off luggage BEFORE the All-State Jazz concert on Friday.

On Saturday, DO NOT bring your luggage to Orchestra Hall unless your parents can meet you there BEFORE the concert.
