Procedures for application and selection of performing groups:

1. Only groups directed by current MMEA members are eligible to apply for consideration.
2. Submit this application, a compact disc recording, and a recent program to the Minnesota Music Educators Association, 6860 Shingle Creek Parkway, Suite 103, Brooklyn Center, MN 55430, by May 10, 2009. Applications must be received no later than May 10, 2009.
3. Recordings must include two (2) selections which offer as much variety as possible. If there are more than two tracks on the recording, indicate which two tracks should be evaluated.
4. All recordings and materials will be carefully examined by an auditioning committee and recommendations made to the Clinic Chairperson. Quality of performance within the context of the school's or organization's available resources will be a determining factor in the final selection. Recordings will not be returned.
5. Invitations to appear on the MMEA In-Service Clinic program will be issued July 2009.
